**Juror Information:** Toby Tannenbaum is an independent professional consulting with museums. She was Assistant Director for Education and Public Programs at the J. Paul Getty Museum from 2008-2014; she oversaw education programs and materials for all audiences at both museum sites and served on the museum's senior management team. She was previously the Director of Education at the Los Angeles County Museum of Art (LACMA). Prior to LACMA she was Associate Director of Education at The Museum of Contemporary Art, Los Angeles. She has served as part-time faculty in the School of Critical Studies, California Institute of the Arts, as adjunct faculty in the School of Fine Arts and the School of Education at the University of Southern California, and as an assistant professor of art education at California State University, Los Angeles. She holds a BFA and MFA from the School of the Art Institute of Chicago.

**Directions: From the WEST:** Any freeway to the 210 Freeway EAST. Exit the freeway at Huntington Drive, exit #33. At the bottom of the offramp turn LEFT on Huntington Drive. Proceed EAST on Huntington Drive to Mayflower Avenue (4 traffic signals). Turn RIGHT on Mayflower. Proceed SOUTH on Mayflower to Jeffries Avenue (a T- intersection). Straight across

Jeffries is the entrance to Vista Del Monte. Drive in the entrance. The clubhouse is the building across from the stop sign. There is very limited parking by the clubhouse. Please park in the marked parking spaces. Bring in your artwork and then move your vehicle back out to Jeffries. NO PARKING in the street in front of the clubhouse!

All accepted artwork will be photographed for use in the 92nd Annual Exhibition Catalog and additional needs by PSA. Artists that live a significant distance from Pasadena, example, Ventura, Ojai, San Clemente, Diamond Bar, Palm Springs, etc., will have their accepted artwork photographed on Saturday. All other accepted artwork will be photographed Saturday or Sunday prior to the pick up time.

**Artwork Pick-up: Sunday, March 5, 3:30 pm to 5 pm.** Please be prompt! No artwork can be left behind at the Vista Del Monte Clubhouse. NO EXCEPTIONS!

**Entry Requirements:** All media & subject matter, NO SIZE Restrictions Limit of four (4) pieces. All Exhibition Policies and Standards will be strictly enforced (copy available at PSA website) 3-D artists need to provide their own display stands.

**Entry Fees:** \$20.00 for entry #1, \$10.00 each for entries #2, #3, #4 plus a contribution of 10% (or more) of gross sales to PSA. Entry fees may be paid via PAYPAL on PSA website or cash or check at the time of entry.

**White's Fine Art Gallery Commission: 35%**

**Entry Package:** Completed (both sections with the same information and signature) entry forms (current entry forms available for download from PSA website), current artist's statement, 150 words maximum, typewritten hard copy please. Statements that exceed 150 words will be edited by the Exhibition Committee to fit the available space in catalog. The Artist's Statement should discuss the artwork entered in the 92nd Annual, not a biography, exhibition history and listing of education, workshops or awards of the artist.

**Special Note:** If your art is very large, very heavy and difficult to move you may submit a CD with several high resolution images (resolution of 300dpi or higher, overall image size of 5 inches x 7 inches or larger please). You may also submit high quality color photographic prints preferably an 8x10 showing the entire work

and several smaller (4x6 minimum) prints showing details. In either case the work must be well lighted and the images in focus.

You MUST notify Lawrence D. Rodgers prior to the take-in of your intent to submit a CD or photographic prints in place of the actual art. Completed entry forms and artist's statement also required. Please contact Lawrence D. Rodgers if you have any questions regarding image specifications or CD format.
