

I spent the morning at the Pasadena Central Library appreciating the stunning craftsmanship seen in the oak interior, the tall windows, and the friendly people. The beautiful display cabinets await our CURIOSITY entries for the October Library exhibition.

Let's make 2015 a memorable 90th year for PSA and our communities. In celebration of this anniversary, we will have a new "banner" graphic for our website and for all 2015 publicity.

The Exhibitions Task Force (ETF) met recently to take a close look at exhibitions' management (volunteers, types of shows, policies, venues, fees, jurors, and schedule). The ETF will meet again September 20th and will report to the Board in October. If you want the ETF to hear your comments, send me an email as soon as possible.

Speaking of Task Forces, if you are interested in helping to create a new Membership Committee, contact me. Marion Dies has been "the Membership Committee" and will continue being in charge of the New Member Screening. PSA is a resource for opportunities other than our PSA-sponsored exhibitions. This outreach occurs as members share news of possible venues. ARTWALK is one of these events. I call this Special Ops for now, but the idea is to network so we can broaden our footprint in and around Pasadena. Pita Jungle Restaurant contacted us as a resource for artists' works to be exhibited at their Pasadena location. More details on Sept 13th, but starting Sept. 3rd, Susan Chesney, Lynn Chang, and George Miller will be the first PSA artists to show at this venue. This is not a PSA exhibition but rather an "artist-direct venue" or Special Ops. Pita Jungle (43 East Colorado Ave) could be an exclusive venue for PSA members only, so check it out and enjoy the food.

George Miller, V.P., is coordinating the Pasadena Playhouse ARTWalk, October 11th. We will have a 10'x 20' canopied space for art, volunteers, and scheduled demonstrations.

BLINN HOUSE (Women's City Club), 160 N. Oakland Ave, will be our new "home" for our monthly meetings – starting October 4th – and for biannual exhibitions. Note that there is a dress code (business casual / no shorts or denim). Currently they are hosting the summer show of California Art League (closes Sept 26).

I look forward to seeing you at our next meeting, September 13th at Pasadena Museum of History - our last meeting at the Museum. Please bring some art-related objects for the raffle. Bring an art friend with you!!
