The Pasadena Library Exhibition, Canvas, Clay, Glass & Paper, will run to October 30. It features 48 artworks by 15 members. The Art of Giving Art will feature PSA members at McGinty's Gallery at the End of the World. It will run from November 23, 2019 to January 4, 2020. PSA has the room and the alcove towards the rear of the gallery. Each artist will have a four foot wide section of wall to display their four to six artworks. Each artwork should be 12 inches by 12 inches or smaller. Prices for the original art should not exceed \$250. In addition, there will be print bins available for participating artists. More information will be forthcoming. All available spaces have been reserved.

Also at McGinty's Gallery at the End of the World, PSA will have the New Members Showcase featuring all the new members from 2019. This will be presented February 2020.

Leah Knecht presented the results of the PSA survey that was sent out sometime ago. 68 members responded. Many suggestions and some complaints were received. The complete report will be sent out via email by the exhibition committee.

George Miller reminded everyone that the Pasadena Artwalk is next Saturday October 12. PSA has a booth on Madison and Green Street that promotes our organization. Members have reserved spots to exhibit a piece of art. However at this time there is no more room.
